SUPPLIES

Each day you will put a grade on your practice and I will go around and grade it at the beginning of class. Use this formula:

$$\frac{\text{Number Correct}}{\text{Total number}} \times 10 = \text{Score}$$

(Your score will usually be a decimal, round to the nearest tenth.)

### Here's the Catch

In order to count for credit, each problem **MUST**

Have two things:

1. Correct Work
2. Correct Answer

You can check the margin to make sure your answer is correct. It is your responsibility to make sure that your work leads to that correct answer. Any problem that does not have correct work leading to the correct answer does not count for credit.
